

What animal do you like the best? In a study, a team from the United Sates and France *conducted online surveys, zoo sites, animated films and school questionnaires to find which animals were popular. The research paper was *published in the U.S. The research team used these *sources to make a list of the top 10 species. The top 10 animals are tigers, lions, (①), giraffes, *leopards, (②), cheetahs, polar bears, *gray wolves and gorillas. Symbolic animals such as (①), lions and giant (②) appear everywhere in movies, books and toys. However, ③ the study found that while these animals are very popular, most people don't know they are in danger.

The complete loss of one species of animal or plant is called "extinction." Of course, no one can dream of these popular animals going extinct, but we all should know what is happening on the earth right now.

We know that about 1,750,000 species of animals and plants are living on this planet. According to the IUCN Red List in 2019, more than 30,000 species of animals are in danger of extinction. They *include gorillas which are facing a lot of challenges and *medaka* which lived in many rivers and ponds when your mothers and fathers were children.

Why are gorillas also on the Red List? According to a study, the main *causes of extinction are *poaching, logging, and *infectious disease. Another big cause comes from mining. We need *cobalt to make electronic devices such as cell phones, *laptops and game consoles. One thing that can be said is that human beings are very much *involved in the *crisis.

When we think of gorillas, try to focus on the fact that they are now endangered and that many other wild animals are in danger as well. If extinction continues, it will affect lots of other animals. We should take an interest in various living things and study about them. For humans, other animals and plants are our friends living together on the earth. Let's think about what we can do and act. Knowledge about extinction is going to protect and enrich our lives.
